The Film Festival, held annually in October revives Jacksonville's glorious moviemaking past by serving as a destination for the independent film community and paving the way for a new generation of talent. The film festival takes place throughout Jacksonville in venues including the Moorish-styled Florida Theatre, built in 1927 as the largest movie palace in Jacksonville and one of only four remaining grand movie palaces of the era in the state, and the San Marco Theater, built in 1938 as an Art Deco masterpiece and currently shows first-run blockbusters and cult classics.
